Treasurer's REPORT 1st JANUARY – 31st DECEMBER 2025

This report covers the Dyslexia Association of Bexley Bromley Greenwich and Lewisham (The Association). The Association has done well with a surplus of £5,096 in 2025. While in 2024 we had a loss of £8.00 and in 2023 there was a surplus of £256.

There has been a great improvement in financial performance in 2025. This is due to receiving a generous donation, more screenings carried out and donations from our members and non-members where most of our income is derived from.

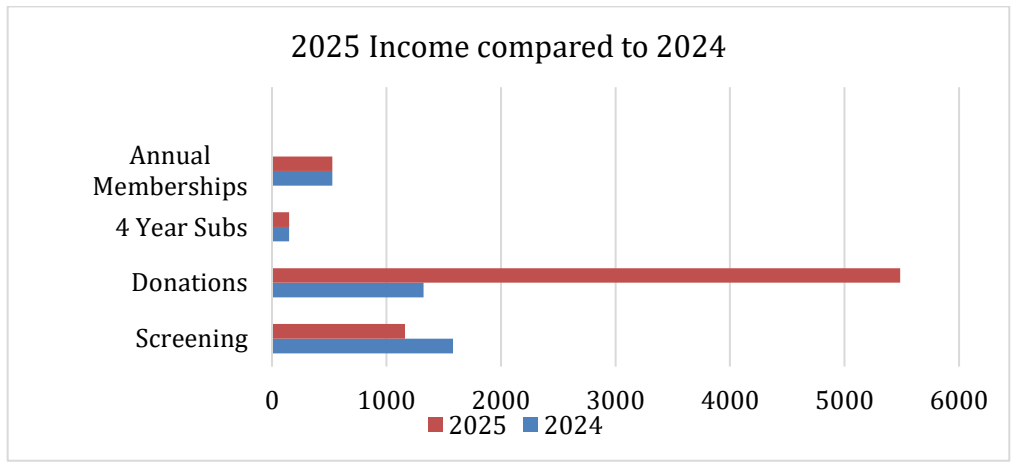
Income generated in 2025 was £7,515 while in 2024 it was £3,640 and expenditure in 2025 was £2,462 and in 2024 it was £3,648.
As you can see, we generated more income in 2025 compared to 2024.

This is mainly due to a generous donation received from another Dyslexic organisation – Kent West Dyslexia Organisation.

Our majority receipts in 2025 were:

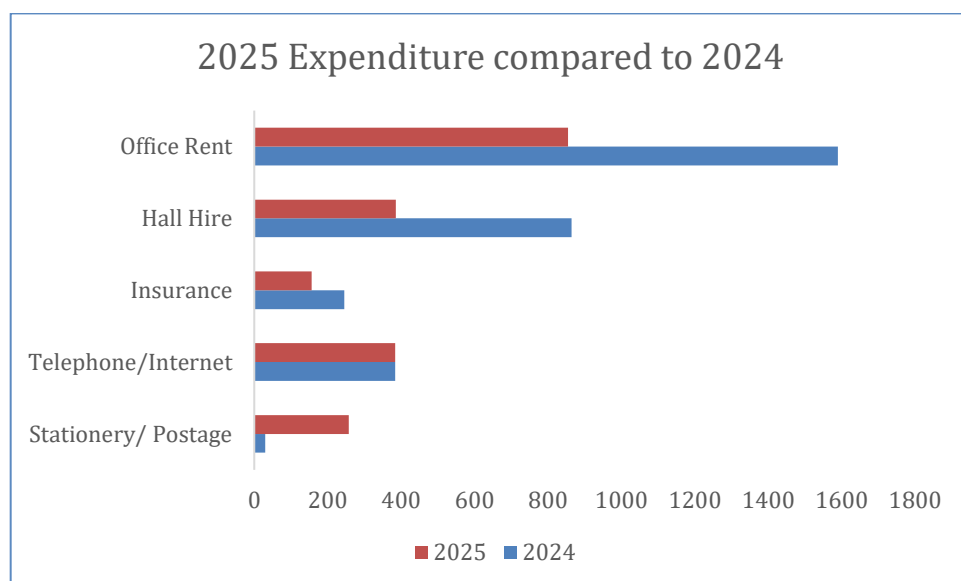
- Screening £1,160 compared to £1,580 in 2024
- Donations of £5,486 compared to £1,323 in 2024
- Annual Memberships £527 compared to £526 in 2024
- 4-year Memberships £150, same as in 2024
- Gift Aid £192

As you can see, our donations have more than tripled.



In 2025, our main areas of expenditure were:

- Screening license £336
- Rent for our office £855, compared to £1590 in 2024
- Hall hire £386, compared to £864 in 2024
- Telephone/Internet £384
- Insurance £156



It might seem that the rent has reduced, but that's not the case. We have had the invoices on time for the correct amount in 2025. In 2024 we received back-dated invoice for 2023 charges in the 2024 financial year.

We are always keen to do more to help our members and local dyslexics, and would appreciate ideas to provide more support, to boost our income and to encourage volunteers to actively participate in our work.

We had a total of £10,770 in the bank at the end of 2025 and £5,716 at the end of 2024.

We did not receive funding from the National Lottery or the British Dyslexia BDA-LDA in 2024.

We still have some reserves, and the Association is financially strong. We are hoping to increase our income in 2026. We continue to welcome offers of help and your generous donations.

I would like to thank all our generous volunteers and, all the Committee for their support and hard work helping local people with dyslexia.
